1870 – The Manitoba Act received royal assent. The act was based on a list of demands espoused by Louis Riel, the Métis leader. The edict included a guarantee that the Métis would receive the title for the lands they had already farmed.

1875 – Prince Edward Island Railway opened. The railroad track meandered, not because of natural obstructions but because contractors were paid by the mile.



1903 – Niagara Falls in Ontario was incorporated as a city.
