Dr. J.B. Orange is a Professor in and the Director of the School of Communication Sciences and Disorders at Western University in London, Ontario. He is an associate Scientist with the Lawson Health Research Institute in the Aging, Rehabilitation & Geriatric Care Centre at St. Joseph's Health Care—Parkwood Hospital in London, Ontario. He is also a Research Associate with the Canadian Centre for Activity and Aging at Western. Dr. Orange's current research projects include; the analyses of language, discourse, and conversation of individuals with Alzheimer's disease, aphasia, frontotemporal lobe dementia, Parkinson's disease, and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis. Other ongoing studies include; communication enhancement education and training programs for family caregivers of individuals with dementia.
