I give, devise and bequeath to the Alzheimer Society of Canada the sum of \$
General % unrestricted:
I give, devise and bequeath to the Alzheimer Society of Canada% of the residue of my estate to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the Alzheimer Society of Canada.
General %, restricted with escape clause:
I give, devise and bequeath to the Alzheimer Society of Canada,% of my estate to be used for the following purpose(s): If the Alzheimer Society of Canada is unable to apply all or part of these funds for the specific purpose(s) stated herein, the balance of this bequest not so extended may be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the Alzheimer Society of Canada.
Residual contingent trust:
Upon the death of the survivor of my (wife, husband, etc.) and my (son, daughter, etc.), I direct my trustee to transfer and deliver the balance of the residue of my Estate, including any undistributed income to, the Alzheimer Society of Canada to be used for any purpose(s) approved by the Board of Directors of the Alzheimer Society of Canada.
