Title of Study: Identity First Language and Person First Language Survey

Location: Canada-Wide

Study Description:

The aim of our study is to gather evidence on the preference between identity-first language (i.e "disabled people") or person-first language (i.e "people with disabilities") for people with disabilities. Participants will complete an anonymous survey online. The anonymous information gathered will be used as part of a live data visualization tool visible to the public for understanding the distribution of language usage between person first language and identity first language.

What Will Happen During the Study?

Participants will complete an anonymous survey online, which takes approximately 5-10 minutes.

Eligibility: Who Can Participate?

All individuals who identify as a person with a disability over the age of 18 can participate.
