- Crows usually travel in groups while ravens travel in pairs
- Crow tail feathers are the same length, while a raven's tail has longer middle feathers
- Ravens have bigger and curvier beaks than crows

- 3. Black Feathers
- 4. Printer

- 5. Crow Silhouette (attached)
- 6. Scissors
- 7. Glue stick
