1775 – American revolutionaries Paul Revere, William Dawes, and Samuel Prescott rode through Massachusetts, giving the warning that "the Regulars are coming out." Later, the phrase "the British are coming" was attributed to Revere. The ride was commemorated in Henry Wadsworth Longfellow's poem "Paul Revere's Ride."

1942 – Colonel James Doolittle led a flight of 16 B-25 bombers to attack Tokyo. Japanese commanders considered the raid deeply embarrassing, and their attempt to close the perceived gap in their Pacific defense perimeter led directly to a decisive American victory at the Battle of Midway.

You Are What You Eat

The technique of grilling salmon on a cedar plank was common amongst tribes of the Pacific Northwest, where salmon was abundant. Plank grilling was not limited to the West Coast. Shad was plank-cooked on the East Coast and even whitefish in the Midwest. Prepare the fish by splitting it and affixing it skin-side-down on an aromatic wood such as cedar, hickory, cherry, apple, or alder. Then, place the plank vertically near the fire, but not too close. A slow-cooked fish will absorb the smoky aromas of the wood without drying out.
