### **Toys of Yesteryear**

In 1927, Charles Lindbergh made his famous solo flight across the Atlantic,



inspiring former Navy pilot Paul Guillow to start a toy company in his barn. Guillow

devised a series of balsa wood model kits, developing 12 different WWI biplane fighters. Each kit had balsa wings, wood cement, aircraft dope, and a bamboo strip for gears and struts. By 1940, Guillow's balsa planes were asked for by name.

### Wild Kingdom

In 1920, train operators steering through the mountain of Japan were forced to stop their trains when they saw thousands of poisonous millipedes crossing the tracks. The insects would mysteriously return every eight years, bringing trains to a halt. It was recently discovered that the millipedes have an eight-year life cycle. They hatch in massive swarms and search for new feeding grounds, a search that forces them to cross the train tracks. The phenomenon has become so regular for the past century that they are called train millipedes.
