1956 – Artist Jackson Pollock, one of the leading figures of Abstract Expressionism, died at age 44 in a fatal car crash near East Hampton,



New York. His passing marked a sudden end to a turbulent but highly influential career in which he became known for his groundbreaking drip painting technique.

2019 – Bianca Andreescu won the Rogers Cup, becoming the first Canadian woman in 50 years to claim the title. The final ended when her opponent, Serena Williams, retired early from the match due to injury. Andreescu's victory capped off a breakthrough season for her and became all the more memorable for the compassion she showed afterward, comforting Williams with genuine empathy in front of the crowd.
