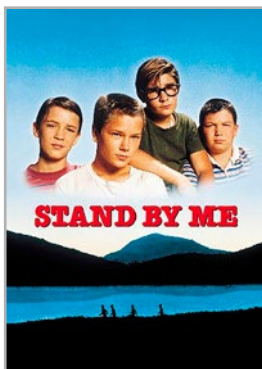

1902 – Created by engineer Henry Leland after the dissolution of the Henry Ford Company, the Cadillac Motor Company was formed, the birth of a brand that would become synonymous with American luxury.

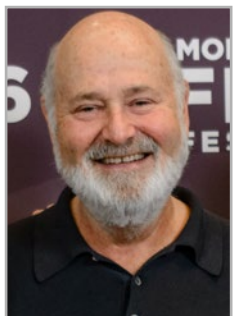
