1910 – By applying an electrical discharge to a sealed tube of neon gas, Georges Claude created the first neon light in Paris, France.

1931 – The British Parliament passed the Statute of Westminster, giving complete legislative equality to Dominion Parliaments. The decree marked the independence of Canada from Britain.

1936 – King Edward VIII announced his abdication of the British throne to marry American divorcée Wallis Simpson, a move that plunged the monarchy into crisis.

1946 – The United Nations Children's Fund, which goes by the name of UNICEF, was established. The humanitarian nonprofit provides aid to benefit children around the world.
