Mary Stuart (1542–1587), also known as Queen of Scots, was the daughter of King James V of Scotland. Stuart was only six days old when she was crowned queen. Her

grandmother was the sister of England's Henry VIII. Many Catholic Englishmen considered Mary to be the rightful sovereign of England



rather than her cousin, Queen Elizabeth (whose parents' marriage was annulled). Mary was married three times, and her life was filled with intrigue. After many years of imprisonment in various castles, Stuart was executed for treason for plotting to assassinate Queen Elizabeth. Her son inherited both kingdoms and became James I of England and VI of Scotland.
