On This Date

1790 – Henry Greathead tested his invention of the lifeboat on the River Tyne in northern England. Named *Original*, the 30-foot-long, 10-oar longboat was designed to right itself in the water and carry almost 800 pounds.

1933 – *The Lone Ranger* was heard for the first time. The famous radio western ran for 2,956 episodes. The first voice of the Lone Ranger, performed by Earle Graser, became as well-known as President Roosevelt's.

1948 – Mohandas Gandhi, the *Mahatma*, or “great soul,” and political and spiritual leader of India's independence movement, was shot and killed in New Delhi.

ANSWER: The Green Hornet. The Lone Ranger's nephew was Dan Reid, Britt Reid's father. That makes the Green Hornet the Lone Ranger's grandnephew.

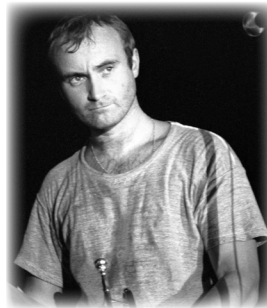
