## On This Date

**1692** – Madeleine de Verchères gathered local farmers into her family’s fortified home when Iroquois attacked. She fired off a cannon to warn other neighbors. Her father, a militia colonel, was a day’s journey away, but the 14-year-old girl defended the fort against an eight-day siege.

**1924** – Toastmasters International was founded with the purpose of improving public speaking skills.

**1978** – Pope John Paul II was inaugurated as Universal Pastor of the Roman Catholic Church. He was the first Polish Pope and the first non-Italian Pope since Adrian VI (1522–1523).
