Clip-and-Stick Necklace

Wrap washi tape around paper clips to make a fashionable, fun necklace.

You will need:

- 44 paper clips (<u>No. 1</u> size; 1 1/4" long)
- Washi tape (1 or 2 designs/colors of choice)

Display a picture of a completed <u>Clip-and-Stick necklace</u>. Or make a necklace and model it to attract crafters. The necklaces are a great item to gift or sell at a craft fair.

Directions:

- 1. Hook 14 paper clips together to make a short chain. Hook the remaining paper clips together to make a long chain of 30 clips.
- 2. Tear off 12 one-inch pieces of washi tape. Wrap tape around the paper clips of the short chain, leaving the paper clips on the ends bare.





3. Wrap more 1" pieces of tape around the clips of the long chain, leaving one of the end clips bare.



- 4. Hook the tapeless clip of the long necklace to the other end of the chain and then wrap tape around the bare clip.
- 5. Hook the short chain to the large one by clipping one of the two bare paperclips to any paperclip on the long chain. Count 12 paperclips and then clip the other bare clip onto the long chain. Wrap the bare clips with washi tape to complete the necklace.



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
