

Painted-Pot Holder

Turn a clay flowerpot into storage for craft supplies.

You will need:

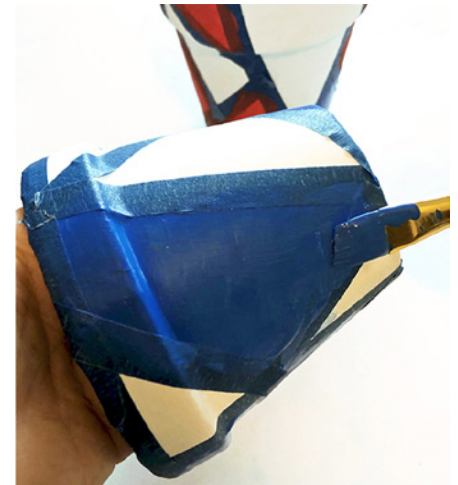
- Clay flowerpot (4" or larger)
- Acrylic craft paint (white plus colors of choice)
- Painter's tape (1/2"-wide)
- Paintbrush and paint supplies

Directions:

1. Paint the flowerpot white. (You may need to paint two coats.) Allow the pot to dry for about 30 minutes.
2. Create a mosaic design on the pot using angled strips of painter's tape. Press the tape down firmly to keep paint from seeping under the tape.
3. Paint the pot in the colors of your choice. Several shades of the same color or 2 or 3 complementary colors are both good choices. Let the paint dry for 30 minutes.
4. Remove the tape and put your new holder to work!
