1939 – Clark Gable and Carole Lombard were married on this day, while Gable was filming *Gone with the Wind*. The marriage was considered one of Hollywood's happiest, but it ended in tragedy when Lombard was killed in a plane



crash in 1942, en route from a war bond drive. Gable later joined the U.S. Air Force and rose to the rank of major.

## Happy Birthday!

Cy Young (1867–1955) is considered one of the greatest pitchers of all time. One of the most coveted awards



in baseball is the Cy Young Award, given annually to the most valuable pitcher in the league. Young has an unbroken record of 511 wins. He also pitched three

no-hitters and a perfect game. He started his career on the Cleveland Spiders with a fierce fastball and then developed an arm-saving and tricky "slowball" pitch, now known as a changeup. After his retirement, Young returned to his farm in Ohio.

## **Toys of Yesteryear**



In 1985, Cabbage Patch Kids dolls were all the rage. The Topps trading card company, taking the advice of their consultant and

Pulitzer Prize-winning cartoonist Art Spiegelman, developed a parody of the dolls, called Garbage Pail Kids, featured on trading stickers. Gross artwork accompanied a name like Adam Bomb or Smelly Sally. The concept was such an international success that *The Garbage Pail Kids* became a live-action movie in 1987.

### Mystery to Me

In late 2020, people began stumbling upon monoliths hidden throughout the world. These strange objects were 10-foot-tall triangular pillars made of metal. The first monolith was discovered in a Utah desert in November by biologists studying bighorn sheep from a helicopter.
