## On This Date

**1830** – In Fayette Township, New York, Joseph Smith, founder of the Mormon religion, organized the church during a meeting with a small group of believers.



**1896** – Male athletes from across Europe and the United States gathered in Athens, Greece, to participate in the first modern Olympic Games. The original games had been banned 1,500 years earlier by the Roman emperor Theodosius I in his effort to abolish paganism.

**1917** – The United States entered World War I.

Icefish have clear blood. Insect blood is yellow. Mammals are red-blooded, and lobsters bleed blue.

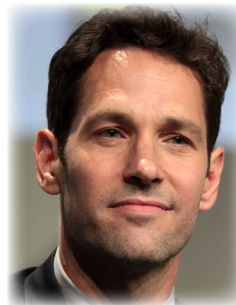

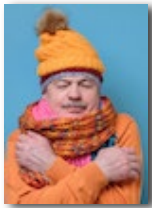

A Colorado man almost died of an allergic reaction when he stepped from his hot shower into the cold of his bathroom.

Originally from the tropics, the man had been experiencing hives when exposed to the cold, but never anaphylaxis. Doctors diagnosed him as having *cold urticaria*, an allergic reaction that results when exposed to cold air, frigid water, or even cold drinks. It is a rare condition that is usually not life-threatening. When exposed to cold, the immune system reacts by releasing histamines, which trigger an inflammatory response.
