DIY Stickers

Color the provided designs and then turn them into stickers (that really stick!) using a mixture of vinegar and glue.

You will need:

- [Sticker designs](#) printed on card stock
- Disposable spoon and cup
- School glue
- White vinegar
- Paintbrush
- Colored markers or pencils
- Scissors (regular and/or pinking shears)



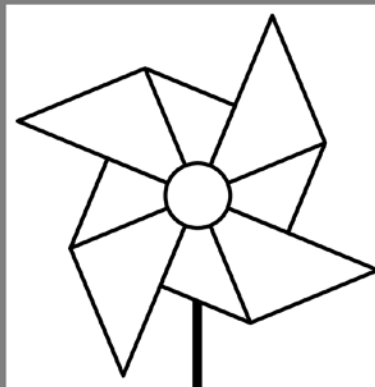
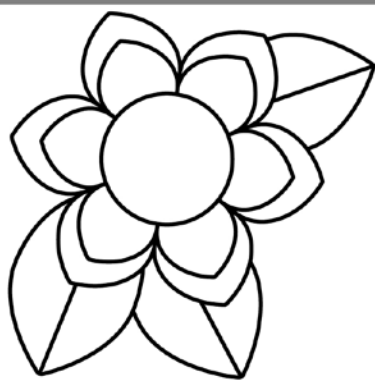
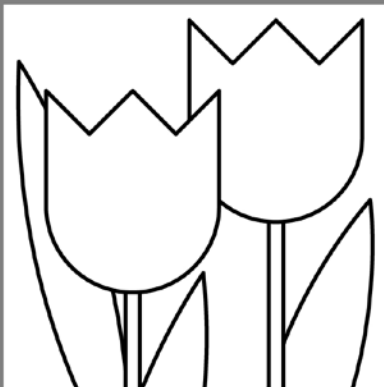
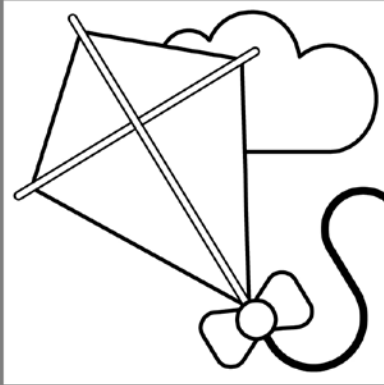
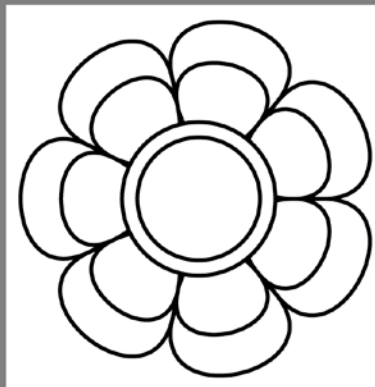
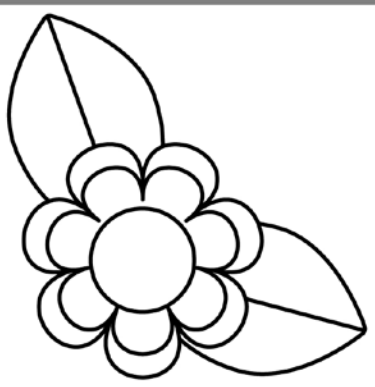
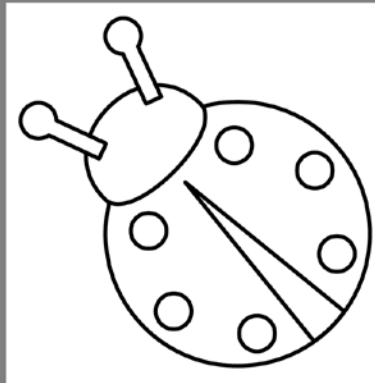
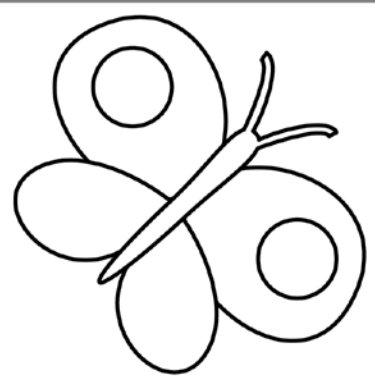
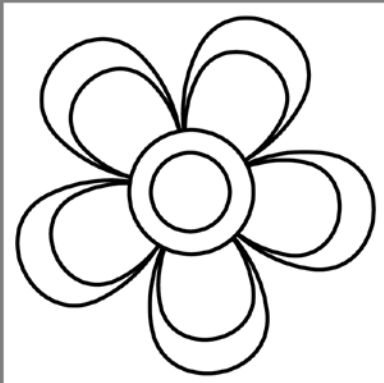
Print a picture of some completed [DIY Stickers](#) to create interest in this project.

Directions:

1. Color the sticker designs. Turn the sheet over so the colored side is facedown.
2. Mix a spoonful of school glue and a spoonful of vinegar in a small cup.
3. Brush a thin coat of the mixture onto the paper and let it dry for 15 minutes before applying a second coat. Let the project dry another 15 minutes.



4. Cut the stickers apart. Use pinking shears to cut around the gray border for an added touch. When you want to use a sticker, moisten the back with a damp cloth or cotton ball.
