

Rustic Vase

Wrap an empty bottle with twine and a colorful ribbon to make an attractive vase.

You will need:

- Empty bottle (any shape or size)
- Twine (enough to cover bottle)
- Ribbon (1–2"-wide, color/design of choice)
- Double-sided tape
- Tacky glue
- Mod Podge and paintbrush
- Scissors

Display a picture of a completed [Rustic Vase](#). Crafters will enjoy making them for tables or room décor.



Directions:

1. Apply 4 strips of double-sided tape evenly spaced on the bottle vertically. Wrap tape around the base and top lip of the bottle.



2. Starting at the bottom of the bottle, wrap the twine around the bottle and move upward.
3. When you come to the base of the neck, add extra double-sided tape, if needed, to secure the twine in place.
4. Continue wrapping until the very top of the bottle is covered with twine. Cut off the excess twine and secure the end in place with tacky glue. Allow the glue to dry for 15 minutes.



5. Apply a coat of Mod Podge over the whole twine-wrapped bottle. Let it dry for 30 minutes. The Mod Podge further adheres the twine and makes it water resistant.
6. Cut the ribbon to size and wrap it around the vase as shown. Secure it with double-sided tape. **Tip:** Periodically replace the ribbon with a new design that reflects the season or a special holiday. Add flowers and display your new vase!
