You will need:

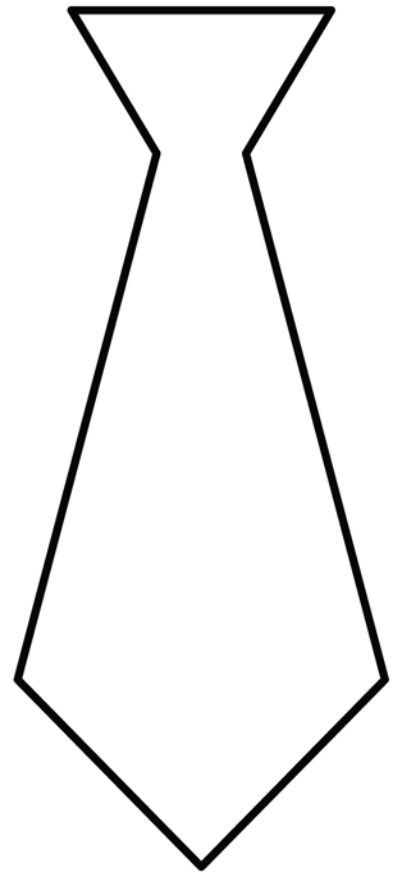
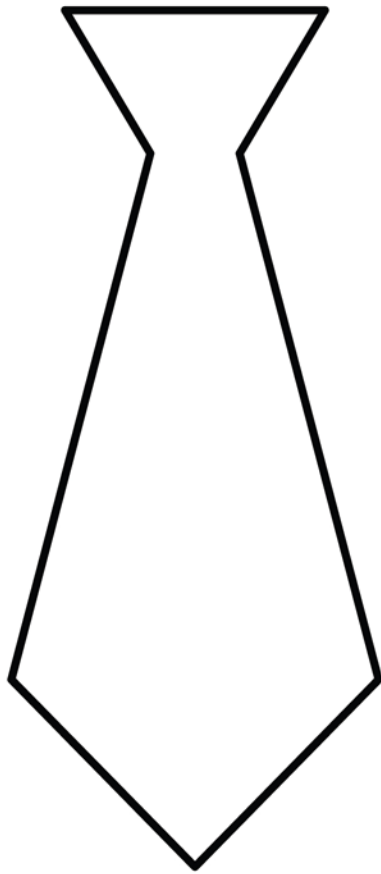
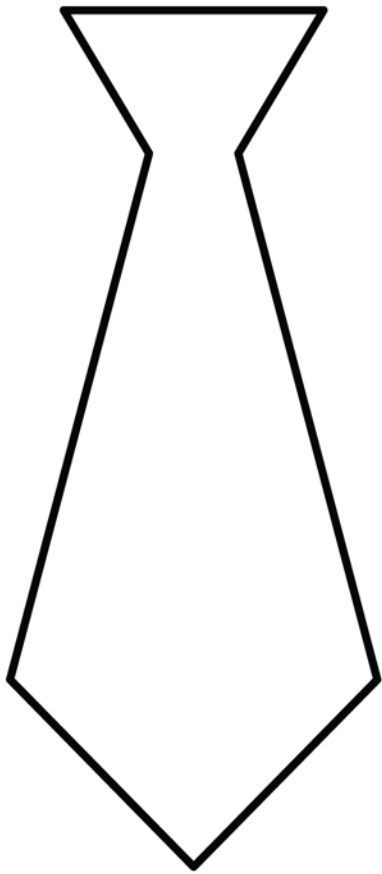
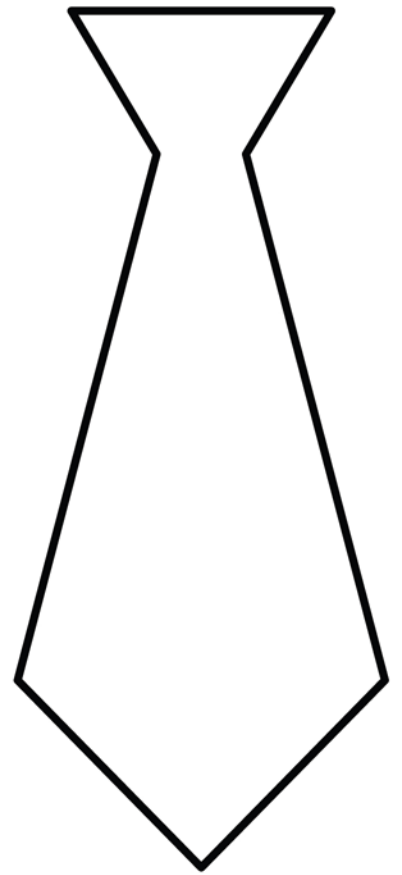
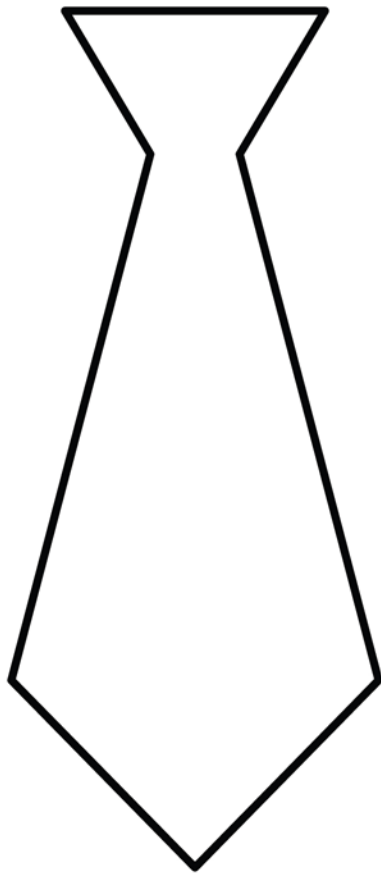
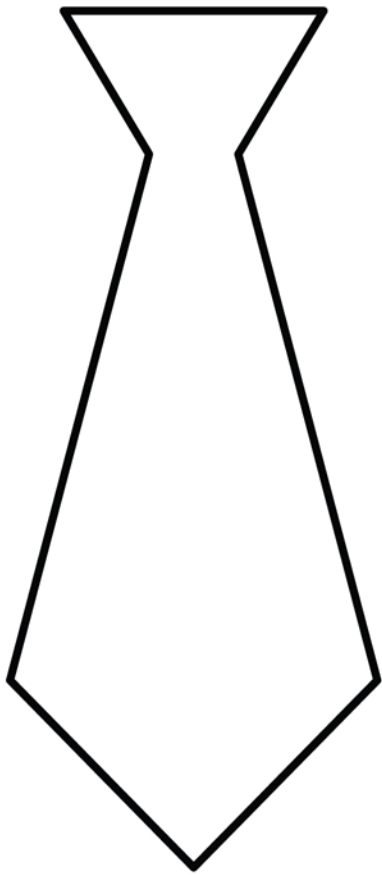
- [Tie patterns](#) printed on card stock

- Treats

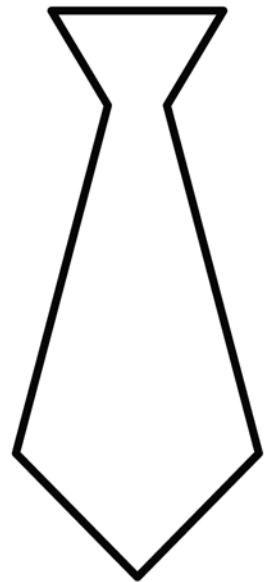
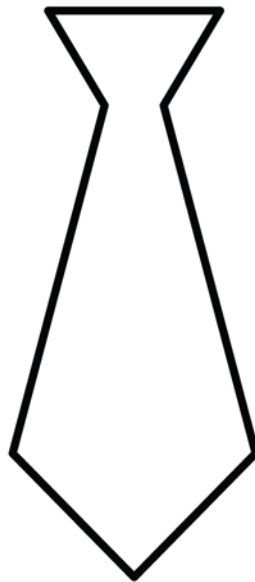
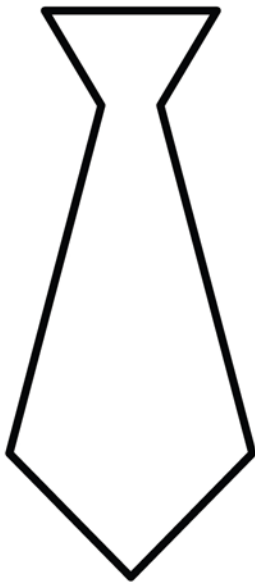
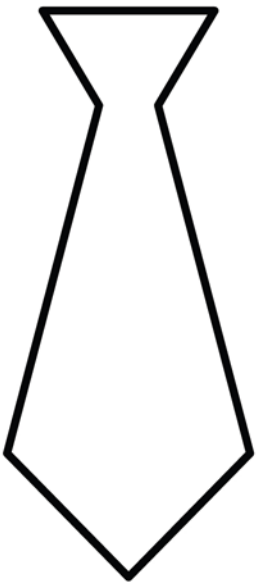
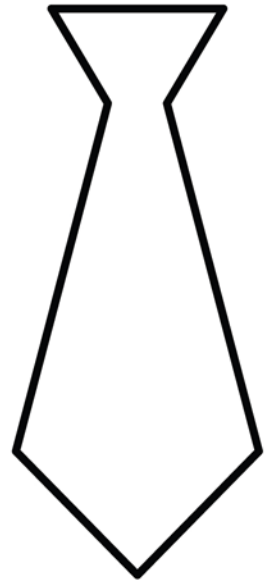
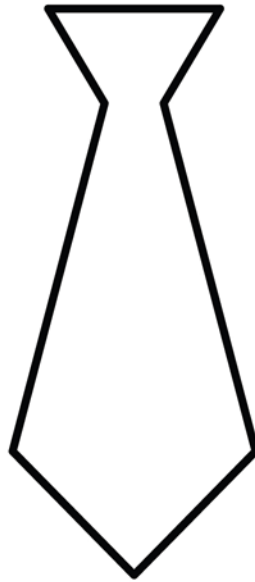
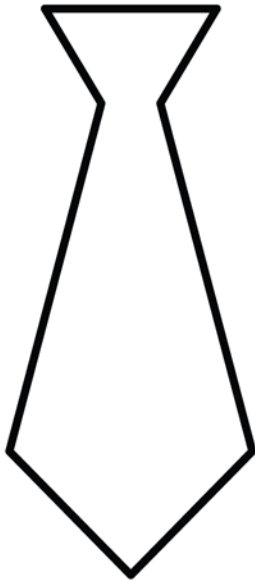
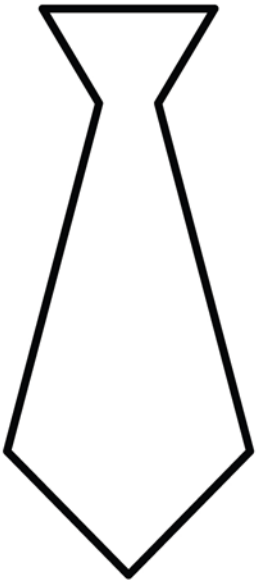
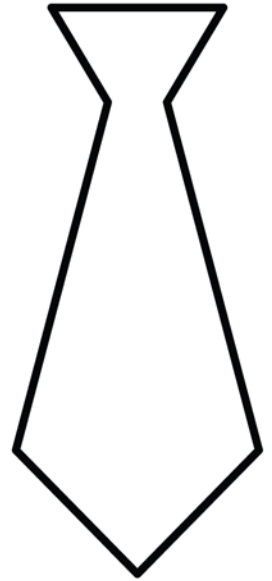
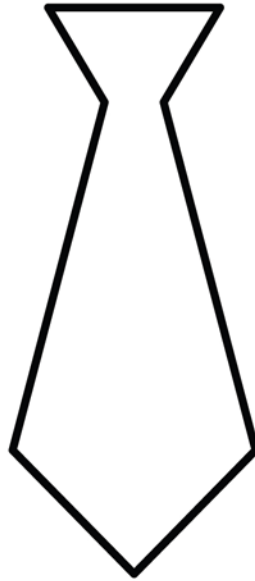
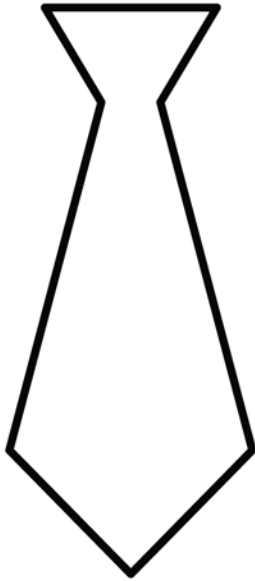
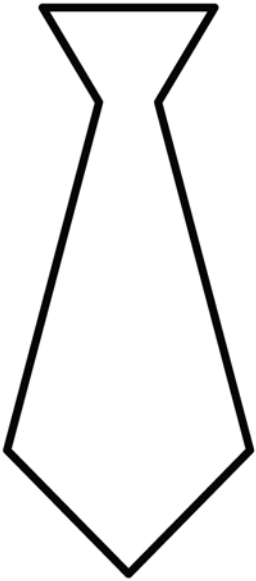


Display a picture of a completed [Tie One On](#). Crafters will enjoy making them to share with family and friends.
