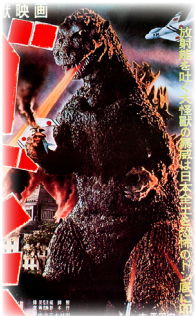

Dolph Lundgren, born in 1957, is a Swedish director, actor, and martial artist who was the Kyokushin karate European champion in 1980 and 1981. Before acting, the multi-talented Lundgren earned a master's degree in chemical engineering and a Fulbright scholarship to study at



MIT. He abandoned his studies, however, after his girlfriend, singer Grace Jones, suggested he move to New York City

to pursue acting. Lundgren quickly found fame with his role as Ivan Drago, Rocky's intimidating Soviet opponent in *Rocky IV* (1985). Since then, he has worked on multiple projects, including *The Expendables* film series.
