
Special Days



Top Attractions

1. <u>Signal Hill National Historic Site of</u> <u>Canada:</u> the site of St. John's harbour defences from the 17th century to the Second World War and where Guglielmo Marconi received the world's first transatlantic wireless signal in 1901.





 <u>Cape Spear Lighthouse National Historic</u>
 <u>Site of Canada</u>: On Canada's easternmost point of land you will find historic Cape
 Spear Lighthouse, the oldest surviving lighthouse in Newfoundland and Labrador.
 <u>East Coast Trail</u>: Home to 25 trails that will take you past towering cliffs and headlands, sea stacks, deep fjords, a natural wave-driven geyser called the Spout and much more!

 <u>Gros Morne National Park</u>: This ancient landscape is a UNESCO World Heritage Site features soaring fjords and mountains that tower above a diverse panorama of beaches and bogs, forests and barren cliffs.
 <u>Fogo Island</u>: The largest island of

Newfoundland and Labrador's lengthy coast that has become a unique, stand-out destination for lovers of art and architecture.
