Jaclyn Gallant and Shelley King will be helping families in West and East Prince by providing essential information, one-on-one guidance and support about Alzheimer's and Dementia, and assisting families to connect with available resources in the community. With the goal of helping people to live well with dementia in the community and stay in their homes and supported for as long as possible, these coordinators will provide families with ongoing follow up throughout the course of the disease to ensure access to the right information and resources at the right time. Additionally, they will be offering ongoing education and support groups in their communities and working with partners across health and community services to ensure families are connected with our specialized dementia supports as early as possible after diagnosis.

Shelley's primary role will be as the Dementia Care Educator, and she will be delivering specialized training to front line health and community service providers such as resident care workers, nurses, social workers, and other staff across Long Term Care,
