

Title of Study: INCARE: Supporting INclusive development of community-based long-term CARE services through multi-stakeholder participatory approaches

Location: Canada-Wide

Study Description:

The aim of the study is to understand how people view care for older people with support needs and how they assess long-term care systems. How do people want loved ones or themselves to be looked after, should they need it? What are their experiences with receiving/providing care? What are their expectations for the future?

Findings from this study will be used to raise awareness of the challenges faced by older people with care needs and their families, to advocate for policies that can support them, and to directly inform the design of socially innovative long-term care service pilots in 3 countries.

This study is being undertaken by a group of international academic, public and non-governmental organisations who are part of the InCARE project (Supporting INclusive development of community-based long-term CARE services through multi-stakeholder participatory approaches), co-funded by the European Union. The European Centre for Social Welfare Policy and Research (Vienna) is coordinating the project and acts as the international contact point.

What Will Happen During the Study?

Participants will be asked about their attitudes, experiences and expectations for long-term care through an online survey. Completing all questions in this online survey will take no more than 20 minutes.

Eligibility: Who Can Participate?

You are eligible to participate if you are over the age of 18.
