

Title of Study: Rare Dementia Support Impact Study

Location: Canada-wide

Study Description:

The Rare Dementia Support Impact Study is a cross-national 5-year collaboration between Nipissing University, Canada; University College London (UCL), England; and Bangor University, Wales, and the world's largest study on rare dementia support. More than 5% of people living with dementia have a rare or young onset type, which is not well understood.

What Will Happen During the Study?

You are invited to participate in learning activities to help us document the needs of people living with rare or young onset dementia and develop tailored support services. Over the study duration, we will be engaging with participants for approximately 2 hours twice a year. Your participation will contribute to strengthening support for people living with rare or young onset dementia in Canada.

Eligibility: Who Can Participate?

You are eligible to participate if you are:

- Living with a rare or young onset dementia (e.g., posterior cortical atrophy, primary progressive aphasia, young onset Alzheimer's disease, behavioural variant FTD)
- Supporting or caring for someone living with a rare or young onset dementia
- Working with or have a professional interest in rare or young onset dementia
- 18 years or older and residing in Canada
