

Title of Study: Beliefs, Behaviors and Medication Management: A Cross Sectional Survey of Adults with Alzheimer's or Parkinson's Disease

Location: Ontario

Study Description:

The aim of this study is to investigate the in-home medication use and medication management, beliefs, and behaviors related to medication taking and explore knowledge of and experience with technology and devices intended to aid medication adherence and explore the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on older adult's access to medications, pharmacists, and physicians.

What Will Happen During the Study?

We are looking for older adults aged 65 and up residing in Ontario diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease and/or Parkinson's disease to participate in the study by completing a 10-15-minute survey online through Qualtrics, over the phone, or on paper.

Through this study we hope to identify commonly experienced problems with medication adherence and use of medication adherence aids and technology to allow us to devise and implement new strategies to administer medications to older adults.

Eligibility: Who Can Participate?

You are eligible to participate if you are:

- An adult aged 65 or older living in Ontario
- Diagnosed with Parkinson's disease and/or Alzheimer's disease
