

**Title of Study: Caregiver's attitudes towards using rideshare services and automated vehicles to enhance the mobility of care recipients with dementia**

**Location:** Canada-Wide

**Study Description:**

- Caring for a person with dementia who regularly travels in a motor vehicle with them
- Able to read and comprehend the English language
- Currently living in Canada
