A new study targeting **CARE PARTNERS** of people living with dementia will soon be launched throughout Canada. The study focuses on **Care Partners' Attitudes toward Extending Medical Assistance in Dying to People Living with Dementia**. It will investigate the **beliefs** underlying care partners' **attitudes** on this issue, the **value** they attach to proposed safeguards as well as assessing **the impact of caregiving** and **unmet support needs**.
