

Frequently Asked Questions

Does online fundraising raise more money?

Yes. Walk statistics report online donations can be up to 25% higher than a direct request.

Q: How do I register?

Register online or bring your pledge sheet and register on the day of the Walk. Either way, all walkers must “check in” to register on the day of the Walk at the registration tables.

What are the event proceeds used for?

Event proceeds are used to provide financial support for the programs and services we provide to individuals living with Alzheimer’s disease or other dementias, their family members and caregivers, and the general public. All the proceeds from the event remain in Oxford County.
