

2019 Request for Applications: ASRP/AGE-WELL Doctoral Award /Postdoctoral Fellowship

1. Program Objective

This program is designed to support trainees through the AGE-WELL (Aging Gracefully Across Environments Using Technology to support Wellness, Engagement and Long Life) Network of Centres of Excellence Training Program in partnership with the Alzheimer Society of Canada.

2. Mechanisms of Support and Eligibility

The funding partners, [AGE-WELL](#) NCE and the [Alzheimer Society Research Program](#), will co-fund up to **two Doctoral Awards / Postdoctoral Fellowships**.

Awardees will be required to fulfill the requirements of the AGE-WELL NCE Training Program.

The [Alzheimer Society Research Program](#) (ASRP) in partnership with AGE-WELL NCE will fund:

Type	Duration	Amount	Eligibility
Doctoral Award	3 years	\$76,000 over 3 years	Must be enrolled in a PhD program for 18 months or less at the time of the application deadline.
Postdoctoral Fellowship	1 or 2 years	\$46,500/yr (PhD) or \$56,500/yr (MD)	Must be within the first 18 of obtaining their PhD and must meet criteria outlined in the ASRP Application Guidelines Applications for a postdoctoral fellowship will not be accepted if the applicant has already received or has completed or is already in receipt of a postdoctoral fellowship or its equivalent (defined as in excess of \$40,000/year).

***The candidate’s supervisor must be working within an existing AGE-WELL Workpackage or Crosscutting activity and their project must align with the research program of AGE-WELL. Information about AGE-WELL’s research program can be found online: <http://www.agewell-nce.ca/research>.**

3. Applications

Applications to the program must be submitted by November 9, 2018 to ASC, using the online portal: <https://asc.fluidreview.com/> . Applicants to this program will automatically be considered for Doctoral and Postdoctoral Awards in ASRP’s concurrent competition.
