Exploring Current Transportation Programs Available to Rural Areas of Canada

Study Description:

Purpose: The purpose of this study is to gather information on alternative transportation options in SK for residents living in rural areas.

Procedures: You are invited to do an online survey that will take about 30-45 minutes. I will ask you questions about your experiences getting around the community, the use of health services, what travel modes you typically use, and what alternative transportation options are needed.

Risks: There are no known or anticipated risks to you by participating in this study.

Benefits: It is unlikely that there will be direct benefits to you, however, there is a possibility that your access to health and community services will improve as our results will inform policy makers to develop alternative transportation services that meet the needs of rural residents in Canada.

Storage of Data: Upon completion of five years or when it is no longer required, the electronic data will be erased beyond all recovery.
